



P-16 - External Privacy Notice

This document sets out the Company's policy on the protection of information relating to company information. Protecting the confidentiality and integrity of personal data is a critical responsibility that the Company takes seriously at all times. The Company will ensure that data is always processed in accordance with the provisions of relevant data legislation, including the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR).

Key Definitions

Data processing

Data processing is any activity that involves the use of personal data. It includes obtaining, recording or holding the data, or carrying out any operation or set of operations on the data including organising, amending, retrieving, using, disclosing, erasing or destroying it. Processing also includes transmitting or transferring personal data to third parties.

Personal Data

Personal data is any information identifying a data subject (a living person to whom the data relates). It includes information relating to a data subject that can be identified (directly or indirectly) from that data alone or a combination with other identifiers that Company possesses or can reasonable access. Personal data can be factual (for example, a name, e-mail address, location or date of birth) or an opinion about that person's actions of behaviour.

Sensitive Personal Data

Sensitive personal data is a special category of information which relates to a data subject's racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or similar beliefs, trade union membership, physical or mental health conditions, sexual orientation, biometric or genetic data. It also includes personal data relating to criminal offences and convictions.

Privacy Notice

In order to provide our services, we currently hold the following information:

- Company names and addresses;
- Individual employee names and titles;
- Contact telephone numbers;
- Email addresses.

We gather this data from incoming enquiries, ongoing contracts, new clients, suppliers, consultants and subcontractors.

This data is processed onto our servers, and continuously backed up onto remote servers and 3rd party secure storage using the latest technology.
